ann scholl revises the traditional understanding of the role of imagination and sensory perception in descartes s meditations traditionally cartesian scholars have focused primarily on sensory perception as the more significant of the two special modes of thought in this work ann scholl describes how a better understanding of descartes s skepticism and his arguments for dualism are reached when imagination instead is understood as the more primary of the two special modes of thought the result is a fresh reading and interpretation of descartes

the trilogy forms of representation in the aristotelian tradition investigates how aristotle and his ancient and medieval successors understood the relation between the external world and the human mind it gives an equal footing to the three most influential linguistic traditions greek latin and arabic and offers insightful interpretations of historical theories of perception dreaming and thinking this first volume focuses on sense perception and discusses philosophical questions concerning the external senses their classification and their functioning from aristotle to brentano

first published in 1961 sensation and perception aims to cast light upon the nature of perception itself this the author believes can be achieved only through an understanding of the concepts of sensation and perception a survey of the principal attempts to arrive at such an understanding brings out the fact that perception has most often been assimilated to sensation or judgment the author believes that both of these views are wrong but that an attention to the history of thought can provide an explanation of the temptation to accept them a final chapter gives the author s own views on the nature of sensation and perception as such it would be of interest both to philosophers and to those psychologists who are concerned with the nature of perception

this is the first volume of essays devoted to berkeley s three dialogues between hylas and philonous a classic of early modern philosophy leading experts examine all the central issues in berkeley s work the three dialogues is a dramatization of berkeley s philosophy in which the two protagonists hylas and philonous debate the full range of berkeleyan themes the rejection of material substance the nature of perception and reality the limits of human knowledge and his approach to the perceived threats of skepticism atheism and immorality when berkeley presented his first statement of his immaterialist philosophy in the principles of human knowledge three years earlier he was met with incredulity how could a sane person deny the existence of matter berkeley felt that a new approach was needed in order to bring people over to his novel point of view this new effort was the three dialogues in the preface to the three dialogues berkeley stated that its aim was to treat more clearly and fully of certain principles laid down in the principles esteem for berkeley s work has increased significantly in recent decades and this volume will be the starting point for future research

touch and balance before moving on to more complex material in hearing and vision the text has been extensively updated and this new edition includes a new chapter devoted to attention and perception over 200 new references over 30 new figures and improved more colorful visual presentation a new companion website with a range of resources for students and lecturers the book contains a range of pedagogical features including tutorial sections at the end of each chapter this distinctive feature introduces areas of the subject which are rarely included in student texts but are crucial for establishing a firm foundation of knowledge some tutorials are devoted to more advanced and technical topics optics light measurement bayesian inference but treated in an accessible manner while others cover topics a little outside of the mainstream music perception consciousness visual art foundations of sensation and perception will enable the reader to achieve a firm grasp of current knowledge concerning the processes that underlie our perception of the world and will be an invaluable resource for those studying psychology neuroscience and related disciplines

this book provides a completely new and systematic account of frege s philosophy by focusing on its cornerstone the theory of sense and reference

forms and concepts is the first comprehensive study of the central role of concepts and concept acquisition in the platonic tradition it sets up a stimulating dialogue between plato s innatist approach and aristotle s much more empirical response the primary aim is to analyze and assess the strategies with which platonists responded to aristotle s and alexander of aphrodisias rival theory the monograph culminates in a careful reconstruction of the elaborate attempt undertaken by the neoplatonist proclus 6th century ad to devise a systematic platonic theory of concept acquisition

originally published in 1964 in four essays professor mandelbaum challenges some of the most common assumptions of contemporary epistemology through historical analyses and critical argument he attempts to show that one cannot successfully sever the connections between philosophic and scientific accounts of sense perception while each essay is independent of the others and the argument of each must therefore be judged on its own merits one theme is common to all that critical realism as mandelbaum calls it is a viable epistemological position even though some schools of thought hold it in low esteem

for more than three decades margaret wilson s essays on early modern philosophy have influenced scholarly debate many are considered classics in the field and remain as important today as they were when they were first published until now however they have never been available in book form and some have been particularly difficult to find this collection not only provides access to nearly all of wilson s most significant work but also demonstrates the continuity of her thought over time these essays show that wilson possesses a keen intelligence coupled with a fearlessness in tackling the work of early modern philosophers as well as the writing of modern commentators

many of the pieces collected here respond to philosophical issues of continuing importance the thirty one essays gathered here deal with some of the best known early philosophers including descartes leibniz locke spinoza and berkeley as this collection shows wilson is a demanding critic she repeatedly asks whether the philosophers arguments were adequate to the problems they were trying to solve and whether these arguments remain compelling today she is not afraid to engage in complex argument but at the same time her own writing remains clear and fresh ideas and mechanism is an essential collection of work by one of the leading scholars of our era originally published in 1999 the princeton legacy library uses the latest print on demand technology to again make available previously out of print books from the distinguished backlist of princeton university press these editions preserve the original texts of these important books while presenting them in durable paperback and hardcover editions the goal of the princeton legacy library is to vastly increase access to the rich scholarly heritage found in the thousands of books published by princeton university press since its founding in 1905

plotinus c 205 70 was a neoplatonist philosopher his work posthumously published by porphyry and divided into six books nine tractates each called the enneads in this book majumdar makes a valuable addition to the literature on his work especially ennead iii 7 45 11 13 in particular explaining plotinus cosmology using the genus species model of soul coordinating the literature on the appearance of time and the cosmos with that on the larger issue of plotinian emanation and examining the role of tolma and the restless nature of soul in this conjoint appearance this book investigates plotinian emanation its laws of poiesis contemplative making and the roles of nature matter logos rational formative principle and contemplation and highlights the subtler details of plotinus cosmology by disentangling conceptual issues about the nature of soul and self we and their impact on the process of generation of time and the cosmos

the school of doubt conducts a close philological and philosophical reading of cicero s academica a fragmentary work on sense perception and academic history written in the wake of caesar s victory in the civil wars 45 bce focusing in turn on the author s letters discussing the process of composition the historiographical treatment of the platonic tradition and the critical exploration of philosophical doubt this volume presents cicero as an original and sophisticated historian of philosophy and a radical figure in western skeptical thought widely misconstrued as a technical treatise and a mere chronicle of the greek debates on which it draws the academica here emerges as a key work in the evolution of ciceronian philosophy and of ancient skepticism and one that responds directly to the disintegration of republican rome

for plotinus the nature and status of the human soul is one of the central problems of philosophy ennead iv 3 4 29 constitutes his most penetrating enquiry into this topic addressing the issues of the relation of the individual soul to the world soul the descent of the soul into body its relations with that body problems of personal identity and the nature of memory sense perception and the true seat of the emotions many of which still have a resonance today the treatise is an excellent example of plotinus distinctive method of enquiry not dogmatic though he is no sceptic but worrying away at questions until he has uncovered their complexities to the best of his ability such a work requires detailed commentary such as is provided here to tease out fully the fascinating convolutions of his thought

this study argues both that the proofs are ultimately unconvincing and that plato was aware of the problems the phaedo is shown as a truly dialectical philosophical conversation about the immortality of the soul

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
